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K-196 will be resurfaced in Butler County

Resurfacing will begin soon on K-196 in Butler County.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project – involving a scrub seal and chip seal – will be on K-196 from the Butler/Harvey county line to the K-254 junction. The length is almost 19 miles.

The work is expected to start around Monday, May 20, and be completed around June 5.

During the work, traffic will be controlled by flaggers and a pilot car, and motorists should expect delays of up to 15 minutes.

The map below shows the approximate project location, marked in red.
