U.S. 400 motorists should be prepared to stop for repair in Butler County

Motorists should be prepared to slow down and stop for an emergency culvert repair closing the eastbound lane of U.S. 400 in Butler County.

The repair is at Tallgrass Road, west of Beaumont, on the eastbound side of U.S. 400.

Traffic is reduced to one lane and controlled by traffic signals. Motorists should be prepared to slow down and stop and expect delays of up to 15 minutes.

It is not clear how long the repair will take.
