KDOT hosts five public meetings in May on U.S. 69 Highway Study in Crawford County

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) is launching a listening campaign to hear from Crawford County residents about the current challenges and potentials for the U.S. 69 Highway Study 2024 in Crawford County.

The campaign will kick off in mid-May. KDOT invites the public to attend any of the four in-person open houses or the virtual open house. The in-person open houses will take place at different locations along U.S. 69 in Crawford County.

Each open house will have the same information, with study team members available to answer questions from the public. There will be no formal presentations at the in-person open houses. Those attending can drop by at any time. The virtual open house will start at the designated time, with the team going through study materials and boards presented at the in-person open houses and answering questions from those in attendance.
