U.S. 69 resurfacing project starts this week

Tuesday, May 7, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) expects to begin a resurfacing project on 6 miles of U.S. 69 in Linn County. The project area begins north of K-52 and continues north to Linn Valley.

Project activity includes placing ultrathin bonded asphalt on the driving lanes. Traffic will be reduced to one lane at the work zone with a reduced speed limit. Weather permitting, the road work should be finished by late June.

KDOT awarded Bettis Asphalt & Construction, Inc., of Topeka the construction contract of \$1.9 million.
