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## U.S. 75 resurfacing work starts this week

Friday, May 10, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to begin work on a U.S. 75 resurfacing project in Wilson County. The 10-mile project area starts 4 miles north of Altoona and continues north to end at the Wilson-Woodson county line.

Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one-lane traffic through the work zone; expect delays of 15 minutes or less. Weather permitting, the work should be finished by mid-June.

KDOT awarded the construction contract of \$1.2 million to Vance Brothers Inc. and Subsidiary, Kansas City, Missouri.
