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K-18/K-177 pavement project moving to Phase 3

The Kansas Department of Transportation plans to begin Phase 3 of the pavement improvement project on K-18/K-177 in Riley County tomorrow, May 3, conditions permitting.

During this phase of the project, traffic will be head-to-head on the southbound/eastbound lanes of K-18/177 while the northbound/westbound lanes are reconstructed.

The section of Zeandale Road/K-18 between K-177 and the local access road will also be reconstructed. Work will be done in subphases in order to keep two lanes open to traffic. This area will have a 10-foot width restriction.

This configuration will be in place until July. Signage, channelizers, barricades and temporary pavement markings will direct traffic through the area.

Turning restrictions at the intersections of McDowell Creek Road, Stadel Road, Zeandale Road, Pride Drive, Johnson Road and Acorn Lane will remain in place.
