U.S. 36 project starting tomorrow in Doniphan County

The Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a mill and overlay project on U.S. 36 in Doniphan County tomorrow, May 15, conditions permitting. The 4-mile project spans from just west of the 165th Road interchange to the Missouri River bridges near Elwood.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane where crews are actively working. All lanes will be open during non-working hours. Intermittent ramp closures will also occur at times. Message boards will be in place to alert and direct motorists.

Work will take place Monday through Friday during daylight hours and is expected to be complete by early July.

Herzog Contracting of St. Joseph, Mo., is the contractor on the \$7.5 million project.
