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K-32 bridge repair project underway in Leavenworth County

A Kansas Department of Transportation bridge repair project began this week on K-32 (Linwood Road) over Stranger Creek, approximately one-quarter mile east of Linwood, in Leavenworth County.

The bridge project includes repairs to bridge expansion joints, polymer overlay, and bridge berm and shoulder slopes.

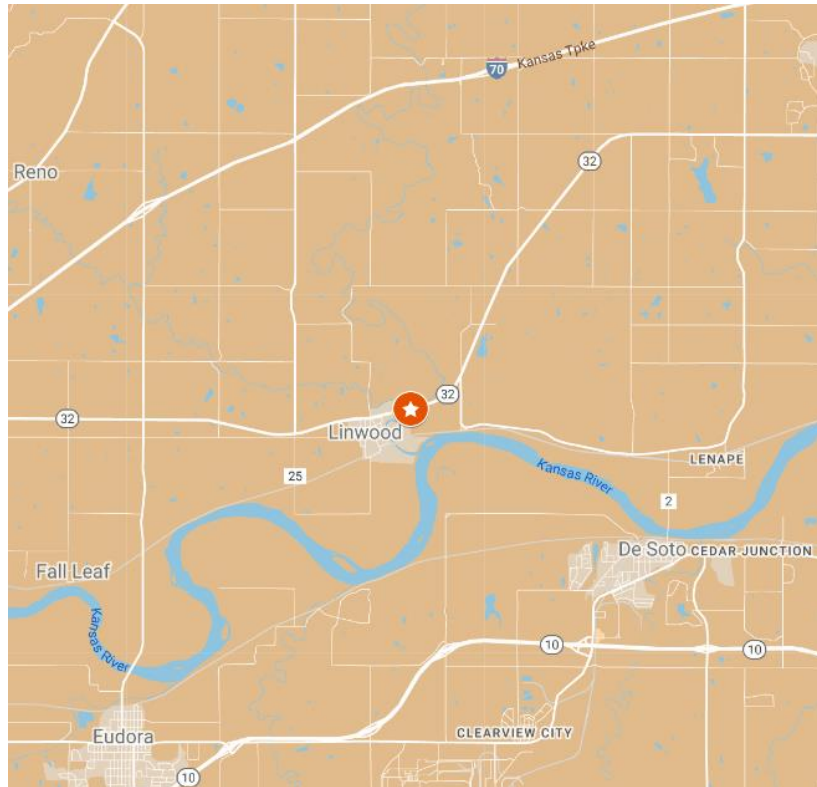
For the duration of the project, traffic through the work zone and across the bridge will be limited to a single lane controlled by a temporary traffic signal.

Temporary pavement markings, channelizers and signs are in place through the project work zone to mark the area and provide advance warning to motorists of lane closures.

PCI Roads, LLC, of St. Michael, Minn., is the contractor for the \$436,000 project. Work will take place daily, Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., and is expected to be completed in mid-July.
