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Asphalt crack repairs scheduled to begin Oct. 26

Crews are scheduled to begin making asphalt crack repairs Oct. 26 in Stafford and Pawnee counties.

The project includes repairs on U.S. 281 from the U.S. 50 junction north to the K-19 junction in Stafford County; K-19 from the Pawnee/Stafford county line east to the U.S. 281 junction; and K-19 from the K-19 spur to the Pawnee/Stafford county line in Pawnee County.

Scodeller Construction Inc. of Wixom, Michigan, is the primary contractor for the \$161,633 project. Crews have 35 working days to complete the project. Traffic will be controlled with a pilot car and flaggers.

The Kansas Department of Transportation urges all motorists to be alert, obey the warning signs and "Give 'Em a Brake!" when approaching and driving through a highway work zone.
