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## Asphalt crack repairs scheduled to begin

## Nov. 26 in Reno County

Crews are scheduled to begin asphalt crack repairs Nov.26 on U.S. 50 and K-14 in Reno County.

Crews will make repairs on U.S. 50 from west of the K-61 junction east to the concrete pavement at South Hutchinson and on K-14 from the west city limits of Nickerson west to the Rice/Reno county line. A pilot car and flaggers will control traffic.

Scodeller Construction Inc. of Wixom, Michigan, is the primary contractor for the \$225,084 project.

The Kansas Department of Transportation urges all motorists to be alert, obey the warning signs and "Give 'Em a Brake!" when approaching and driving through a highway work zone.
