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Bridge guardrail work scheduled in Butler County

Work on bridge guardrail will impact traffic in Butler County beginning March 26.

The prime contractor, J & J Contractors Inc., will reconstruct bridge guardrail at two sites just north of the U.S. 400/U.S. 54 Junction south of El Dorado. Traffic will be maintained, and speed will be reduced to 50 mph. Work is scheduled to begin March 26 and end April 13. Cost of the project is \$87,179.

Bridge guardrail also will be reconstructed on U.S. 400 at Southeast Gray Road about four miles west of Beaumont. Traffic will be maintained, width restricted to 12 feet and speed reduced to 50 mph. Work is scheduled to start March 29 and end April 13. Cost of the project is \$68,595.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert, obey the warning signs and "Give 'Em a Brake!" when approaching and driving through a highway work zone.
