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Work to begin next week on U.S. 77

The first of three projects on U.S. 77 is scheduled to begin April 4.

A \$597,363 milling and overlay project starting at the junction of K-15 and U.S. 77 and heading west to the east city limits of Udall will kick off the work by Venture Corporation, the prime contractor. Traffic will be controlled through the work zone by flaggers and a pilot car.

A \$968,954 milling and overlay project starting at the junction of K-15 and U.S. 77 heading north to the Butler/Cowley line will follow. It is scheduled to start April 9 and finish May 25. A pilot car will direct traffic.

A \$1,060,149 surfacing project starting south of the junction of U.S. 77 and the Arkansas City Bypass north to Quail Ridge Drive in Cowley County will conclude the work. It is scheduled to begin May 1 and finish at the end of May. Traffic will be down to one lane in each direction.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert, obey warning signs and "Give 'Em a Brake!" when approaching and driving through a highway work zone.

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
