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Crews to remove bridge on U.S. 54 in Butler County

A project to remove a bridge on U.S. 54 that carries southbound traffic over a former railroad line is scheduled to begin June 18.

The bridge is just north of the U.S. 400 East junction. The prime contractor, Dondlinger Construction of Wichita, also will reduce the grade and resurface the roadway in that area.

The \$796,170 project is expected to be completed in early September.

Traffic will be controlled at a reduced speed.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert, obey the warning signs and "Give 'Em a Brake!" when approaching and driving through a highway work zone.
