Milling and overlay work starts on U.S. 183

in Pawnee County

A milling and overlay project is underway on U.S. 183 from the junction of U.S. 56 to the junction of K-156 in Pawnee County.

The \$1,163,199 project involves about 12 miles. The primary contractor, Venture Corporation of Great Bend, has 25 working days to complete the job.

Motorists should expect delays of no more than 15 minutes. Flaggers and a pilot car will direct traffic.

The Kansas Department of Transportation urges all motorists to be alert, obey the warning signs and "Give 'Em a Brake!" when approaching and driving through a highway work zone.
