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Crack repairs scheduled on U.S. 160

Crack repairs to various locations on U.S. 160 in Cowley, Harper and Sumner counties are scheduled to begin Aug. 27.

Pavement Pros LLC of McPherson is the primary contractor for the \$128,181 project.

Traffic will be controlled with flaggers and a pilot car. Attached is a map of where crews will be working.

The contractor has 50 working days to complete the project but expects to be finished in about two weeks. Crews will start work in Harper County, then move on to Sumner and Cowley counties.

The Kansas Department of Transportation urges all motorists to be alert, obey the warning signs and "Give 'Em a Brake!" when approaching and driving through a highway work zone.
