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## Two Bridges on Westbound K-96 to be Repaired

A Kansas Department of Transportation contractor will begin repairs on two westbound K-96 bridges at the I-235/K-96/N. Meridian interchange on Monday, August 17. During the first phase of the project, the ramp from northbound I-235 to westbound K-96 will be closed.

A signed detour will direct traffic from northbound I-235 wanting to go westbound on K-96 to exit onto Meridian, travel north on Meridian ¼ mile then turn left onto the ramp to westbound K-96.

Repairs to the two bridges that span the Big Arkansas River will include expansion joint replacement, bridge deck patching, polymer overlays and other repairs.

Wildcat Construction Company of Wichita is the contractor on the \$817,447.93 project. It is scheduled to be completed in late October if work progresses without delays caused by weather.
