
K-53 at Mulvane will stay closed longer for RR crossing repair

K-53 will remain closed longer -- through Tuesday night, June 7, until sometime Wednesday morning, June 8 -- so crews can complete repairs on a railroad crossing on the west side of Mulvane.

The map below shows the approximate location of the closing, marked with a red dot.

Signs will direct traffic to an official detour. KDOT uses state highways for official detour routes for safety, weight and maintenance concerns.

The detour is outlined in red on the map below.
