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U.S. 183 in Comanche, Kiowa counties getting crack-repair work

A crack-repair project will start soon on U.S. 183 in Comanche and Kiowa counties.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project involves crack repair on U.S. 183 from the north U.S. 160 junction at Coldwater, in Comanche County, north to the U.S 54/400 junction near Greensburg, in Kiowa County. The length is almost 23 miles.


The work is expected to start around Nov. 28 and be completed around Dec. 23.

During the work, traffic will be controlled by flaggers and a pilot car, and motorists should be prepared to slow down and stop and expect delays of up to 15 minutes.

Scodeller Construction Inc., of Wixom, Michigan, is the primary contractor for the \$286,024 project.
