Field survey is set for bridge replacement at El Dorado State Park

A field survey is scheduled to begin around Monday, April 11, for proposed replacement of the K-900/East 12th Avenue bridge over the Walnut River at El Dorado State Park.

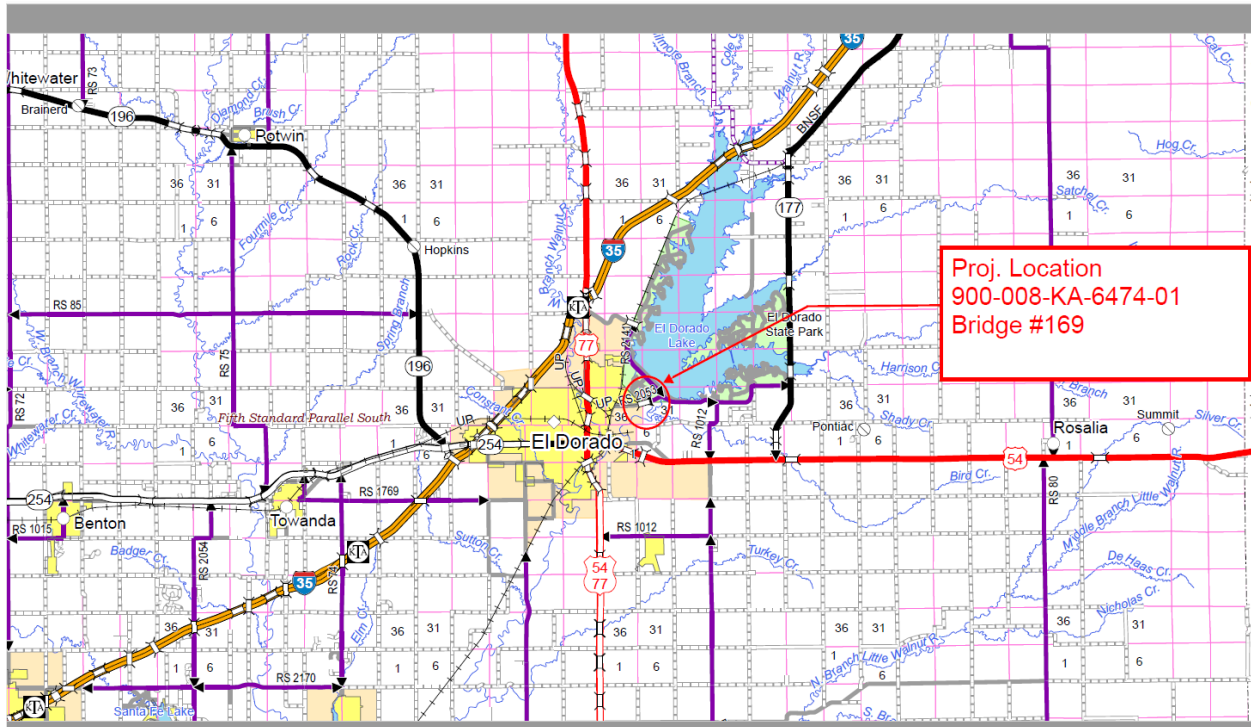
This would be a Kansas Department of Transportation project. The approximate length of the survey is 2000 feet, and the survey will be based on the existing alignment.

This field survey will gather information needed for detailed design of the proposed improvement. The survey is expected to be completed by May 17.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property if needed. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
