## Field survey will aid design of U.S. 50 ramp to I-135

Department of Transportation

A field survey of the I-135/U.S. 50 interchange on the north side of Newton has been scheduled to aid the design of a ramp from westbound U.S. 50 to northbound I-135.


The length of the survey is 6,000 feet, and the survey will be based on the existing alignment.

This field survey, expected to begin around Monday, Nov. 21, will gather information needed for the detailed design of the proposed improvement. The survey is estimated to be completed by Feb. 1, 2023.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
