Pipe work on U.S. 160 west of Wellington is set

Work to install a pipe under U.S. 160 west of Wellington is expected to begin around Thursday, March 21.

The work, overseen by the Kansas Department of Transportation, will be on U.S. 160 at Maize Road, west of Wellington.

During the work, traffic will be reduced to one lane and controlled by a temporary signal. Motorists should be prepared to stop and face a delay of less than 5 minutes. There will be a width restriction of 12 feet.

The work is expected to be completed around March 29.
