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U.S. 166 pavement marking project is set in Cowley County

A pavement marking project will start soon on U.S. 166 in Cowley County.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project will be from the north junction of U.S. 77/U.S. 166 at Arkansas City east to the Chautauqua County line. The length is 28.4 miles.

The work is expected to begin around April 1 and be completed around May 3.

During the work, traffic will be controlled by flaggers and a pilot car, and motorists should be prepared to slow down and stop and face delays of up to 15 minutes.
