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## **K-2 bridge replacement, detour to start soon in Barber County**

Work will begin soon on a bridge replacement project on K-2 in Barber County.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project is over Little Mule Creek almost 2 miles east of U.S. 281.

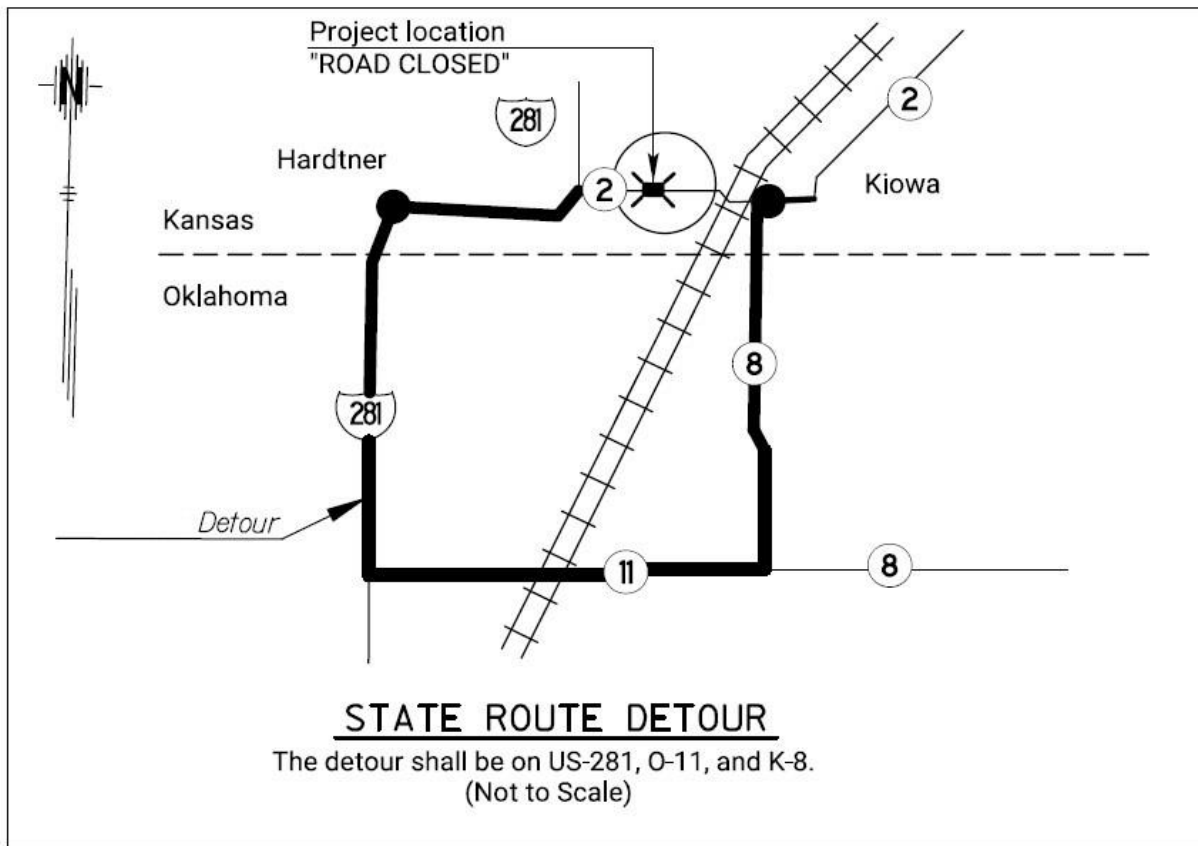
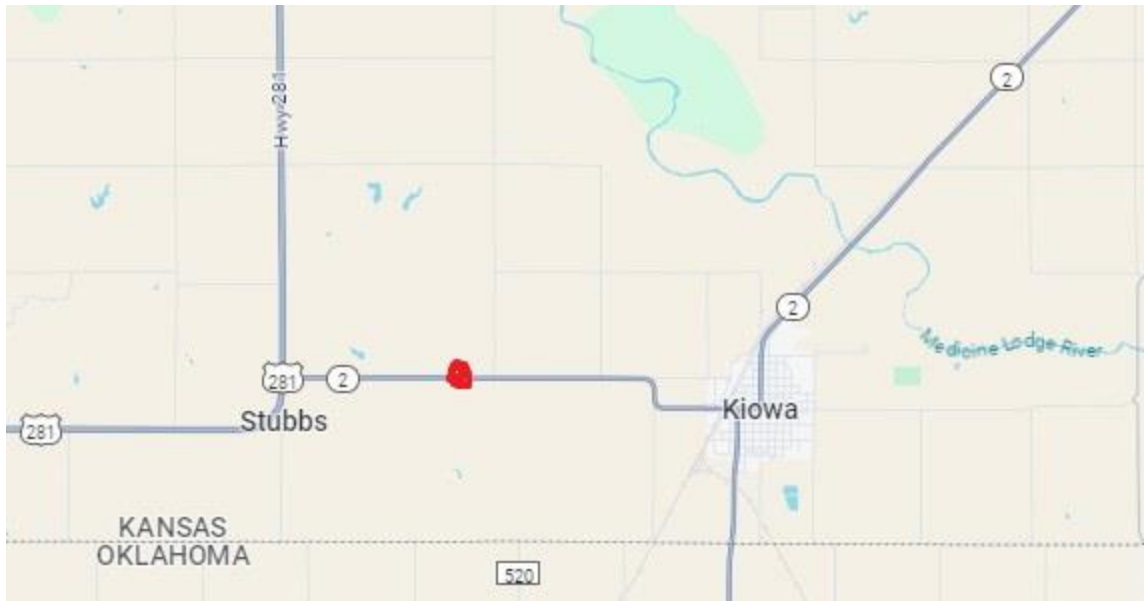
The work is expected to begin around July 8 and be completed around March 7, 2025.

During the work, the bridge will be closed, and motorists will be directed to a detour using U.S. 281, O-11 (in Oklahoma), O-8 (in Oklahoma) and K-8. KDOT uses state highways for official detour routes for safety, weight and maintenance concerns.
