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U.S. 54/77 resurfacing in Butler County is set

Work will begin soon on a U.S. 54/77 resurfacing project in Butler County.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project will be a milling and hot-mix-asphalt overlay on northbound lanes of U.S. 54/77 from the U.S. 400 junction to the south side of El Dorado, with the work expected to begin on the south end of the project and move north. The length is about 8.3 miles.

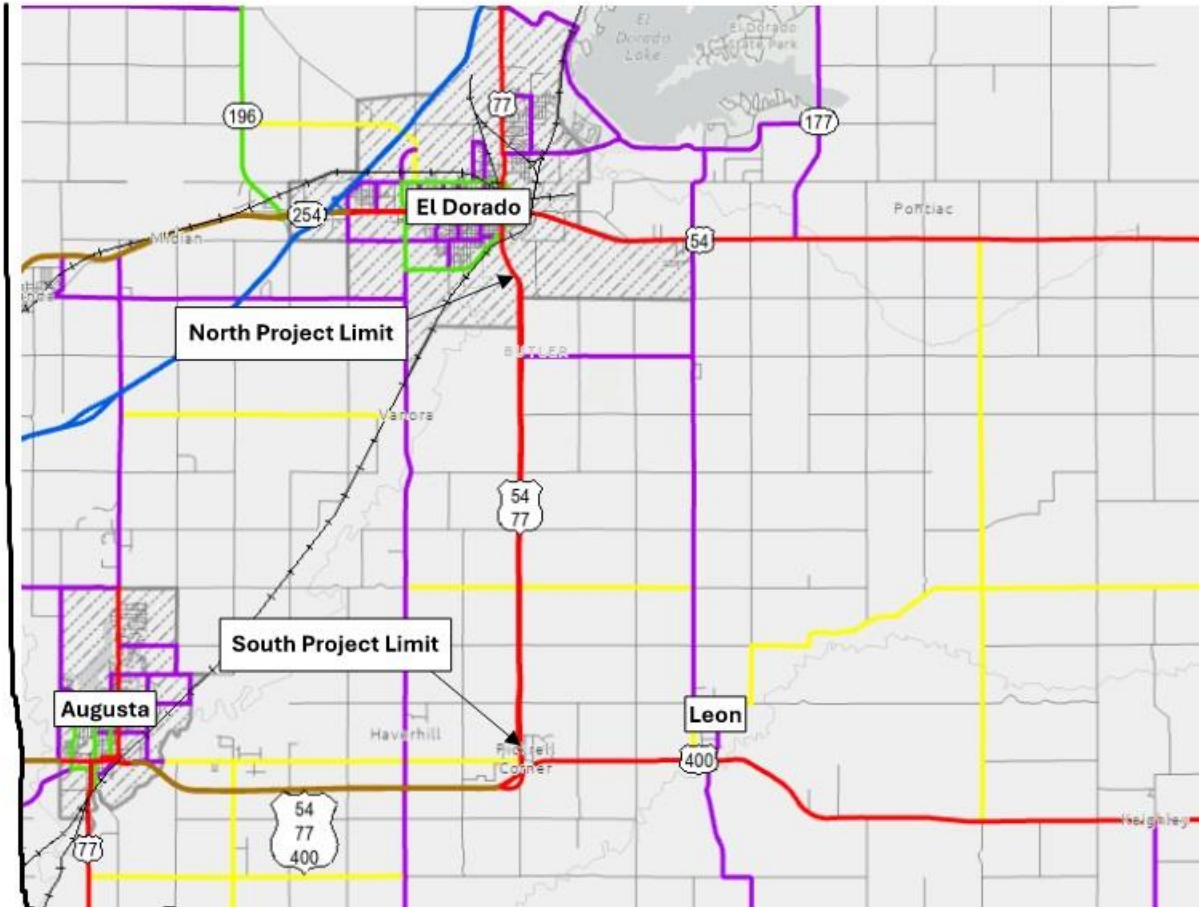
The work is expected to start around April 1 and be completed around mid-June.

During the work, traffic will be shifted to one lane, and motorists will be directed to drive at a reduced speed.
