### **U.S. 81 crack repair in Sumner County to begin soon**

A U.S. 81 crack repair project in Sumner County is expected to start around Monday, Feb. 26.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project will be on U.S. 81 from East 60<sup>th</sup> Street South continuing north to the Sumner/Sedgwick county line -- excluding Wellington. The project length is a little over 30 miles.

The project is expected to be completed around March 22.

During the work, traffic will be restricted to one lane and controlled by flaggers and a pilot car. Motorists should expect to slow down and stop and face a delay of up to 15 minutes.
