Field survey starting for U.S. 160 culvert replacement in Cowley County

A field survey for a proposed U.S. 160 culvert replacement is expected to begin Monday, Nov. 6


The location is about 7.4 miles west of the Cowley/Elk county line. The survey length is 2,500 feet, and the survey is based on the existing alignment.

The field survey will gather information needed for the detailed design of the proposed improvement. It is estimated to be completed by Jan. 12.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
