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Repair starting soon on K-254, U.S. 54/400 bridges in Butler County

Repair will begin soon on two bridges in Butler County, one on K-254, the other on U.S. 54/400.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project will repair the K-254 bridge over the Whitewater River just west of Towanda and the U.S. 54/400 bridge over the Whitewater River just west of Augusta.


The K-254 bridge work is expected to start around Monday, Oct. 9, and be completed that day. The U.S. 54/400 work is expected to begin around Tuesday, Oct. 10, and be completed that day. Both repairs will be on westbound bridges.


During the work, traffic will be restricted to one westbound lane. Motorists on K-254 will be directed to slow down to 55 mph approaching the bridge; motorists on U.S. 54/400 will be directed to slow down to 50 mph approaching the bridge.
