U.S. 166 guardrail survey begins in November

Thursday, Nov. 4, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to start a survey for guardrail updates on U.S. 166 in Montgomery County. The survey area begins east of 1900 Road and continues east to end ½ mile east of 3950 Road.

KDOT expects the survey to be complete by Dec. 3. Activities include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. A member of the survey crew will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property. KDOT Field Survey Project Manager Kara LaRiviere will manage the survey.
