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K-31 bridge survey begins in Anderson County

Wednesday, April 28, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to begin a field survey at the Pottawatomie Creek Bridge on K-31 in Anderson County. The bridge is eight miles west of Garnett.

The length of the survey is approximately 6,500 feet on the existing highway alignment. Survey findings will be used to design a bridge replacement project. KDOT expects the survey to be finished by July 1. Activities include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor.
