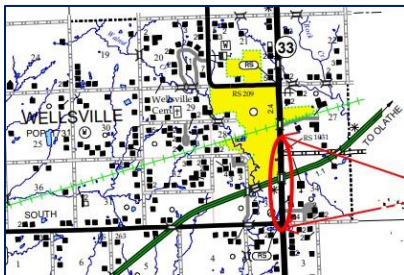
Survey on K-33 bridge over I-35 starts this month

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to begin a field survey on the K-33 bridge over I-35 at Wellsville on Monday, Oct. 25.

The length of the survey is 1.3 miles on the existing alignment. Survey crew members will gather information for the detailed design of a proposed improvement to replace the bridge.

KDOT expects the survey to be complete by Dec. 31. Activities include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. A member of the survey crew will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property. KDOT Field Survey Project Manager Joe Bowen will manage the survey.
