

Asphalt patching on K-39 next week

The week of July 23-27 maintenance crews with the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will place asphalt patches on K-39 between the west U.S. 75/K-39 junction and the U.S. 400/K-39 junction in Wilson County.

A pilot car operation will guide one-lane traffic through the work zone during daylight hours. Travelers can expect delays of 15 minutes or less.
