KDOT to patch concrete on U.S. 400

Monday, April 19, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to begin a full depth concrete patching project on U.S. 400 in Greenwood County. The project area runs from the north K-99/U.S. 400 junction east to the Greenwood-Wilson County line.

Temporary traffic signals will direct one-lane traffic through the work zone. Expect delays of 15 minutes or less. Weather permitting, the road work should be finished by mid-May.
