KDOT patching concrete on U.S. 400 in Montgomery County

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) has started a full-depth concrete patching project on a section of U.S. 400 in Montgomery County. Crews are replacing concrete at locations between U.S. 75 and the Montgomery-Labette County line.

Work zone traffic is reduced to one lane with signals. Expect delays of 10 minutes or less. Weather permitting, the road work should be finished by the end of November.
