KDOT patching concrete on U.S. 400 in Wilson County

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) has started a full-depth concrete patching project on a section of U.S. 400 in Wilson County. The project area begins at the Greenwood-Wilson county line and continues southeast to K-47 at Fredonia.

Work zone traffic is reduced to one lane with signals. Expect delays of 15 minutes or less. Weather permitting, the road work should be finished by the end of July.
