U.S. 400 repairs in Wilson County

Beginning Tuesday, Sept. 16 and continuing for the rest of this week, weather permitting, maintenance workers with the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will make repairs on U.S. 400 two miles southeast of Fredonia.
