Rail crossings on U.S. 400 close for repairs April 11-14

Monday through Thursday, April 11-14, the BNSF Railway and South Kansas & Oklahoma Railroad (SKOL) will close and make repairs at the two rail crossings on U.S. 400 east of K-7 at Cherokee. Both crossings will be closed to through traffic at the work zone.

The signed detour route for U.S. 400 eastbound traffic: from U.S. 400 at Cherokee proceed south on K-7 to K-103, then east on K-103 to U.S. 69, then north on U.S. 69 to U.S. 400. Westbound traffic should take the same detour route in the opposite direction.
