KDOT to begin survey for U.S. 54 overpass replacement

Starting Tuesday, Jan. 27, and continuing for four weeks, weather permitting, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will conduct a field survey at the overpass above the Union Pacific Railroad on U.S. 54 at Moran. The overpass is ¼ mile east of the U.S. 54/U.S. 59 junction.

The survey is taking place to gather information necessary for a detailed design of the proposed overpass replacement. The survey length is approximately 2,000 feet, beginning at the U.S. 59 intersection and continuing east/southeast to the New Hampshire Road intersection.

Activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. A member of the survey crew will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Joseph Bowen, field survey project manager, is in charge of this survey.
