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KDOT to resurface section of U.S. 54

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) expects to begin a resurfacing project on U.S. 54 in late September. The road work starts at the west K-99 junction and continues east to the city limits of Yates Center.

Project activity includes a mill and overlay. Flaggers and a pilot car will guide one-lane traffic through the work zone; expect delays of 15 minutes or less. The project should be completed by late autumn, weather permitting.

KDOT awarded the construction contract of \$4.7 million to Shilling Construction of Manhattan, Kansas.
