KDOT begins resurfacing projects on K-58

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) has started work on two projects to resurface K-58. The 15-mile combined project area begins at the west city limits of Leroy and continues east to end at U.S. 169.

Flaggers and a pilot car are guiding one-lane traffic through the work zone during daylight hours; expect delays of 15 minutes or less.

The resurfacing work should be finished in one month, weather permitting. Bettis Asphalt & Construction, Inc., of Topeka is contractor on the projects, which have a combined construction cost of \$1.1 million.
