U.S. 69 bridge project to begin in Linn County

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will on Monday, Sept. 21, start a repair project on the southbound U.S. 69 bridge over the Marais des Cygnes River. The bridge is approximately one mile south of the north K-52 junction.

The abutment seal at both ends of the bridge will be replaced and the deck will be patched. Southbound traffic will be reduced to one lane with a speed limit of 65 miles an hour.

KDOT awarded the \$181,309 construction contract to PCI Roads, Topeka. The project should be completed by late November, weather permitting.
