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K-7 resurfacing project starts in June

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) expects to begin a resurfacing project on K-7 in Crawford County the week of June 7. The project area starts at the U.S. 400 junction and continues north for 11 miles, ending at the south city limits of Girard.

Project activity includes a shoulder chip seal and microsurfacing on the driving lanes. Flaggers and a pilot car will guide one-lane traffic through the work zone; expect delays of 15 minutes or less on days when the project is active.

KDOT awarded the construction contract of \$792,062 to Vance Brothers, Inc., of Kansas City, Mo. Weather permitting, the project should be finished by late June.
