## K-7 railroad crossing repairs set for Nov. 17

The South Kansas & Oklahoma (SKOL) Railroad will close and repair its crossing on K-7 between U.S. 400 and K-103 on Wednesday, Nov. 17. The daylong closure is expected to begin at 8 a.m. and continue until 5 p.m.
