KDOT to replace bridge on K-99 in Greenwood County

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) expects to begin work in early May on a project that will replace a bridge on K-99. The bridge spans the Fall River and is 2.3 miles south of the west U.S. 54/K-99 junction.

K-99 traffic will be placed on a temporary road around the work zone. The bridge replacement should be completed early in 2022, weather permitting. Bridges Inc. of Newton is the primary contractor on the \$3.8 million project.
