## KDOT to begin survey at K-126 bridge over Middle Cow Creek

Starting Wednesday, March 11 and continuing for three weeks, weather permitting, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will conduct a field survey at the Middle Cow Creek Bridge on K-126 in Crawford County. The bridge is one mile west of the K-126/U.S. 69 junction at Pittsburg.

The survey length is approximately one-half mile along the existing alignment of K-126. The survey is taking place to gather information necessary for a detailed design of a proposed project to replace the bridge. Activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor.

A member of the survey crew will first contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Rob Selley, P.S., Field Survey Project Manager, is in charge of this survey for KDOT.
