## KDOT to begin field survey for bridge replacement on K-31

Starting Monday, Nov. 24 and continuing for six weeks, weather permitting, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will conduct a field survey at the North Fork Little Osage Drainage Bridge on K-31 in Anderson County. The bridge is 2.09 miles east of the U.S. 59/K-31 junction. The approximate length of the survey will be 2,900 feet at the bridge site.

The survey is taking place to gather information necessary for a detailed design of a proposed project to replace the bridge. Activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. A member of the survey crew will first contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Martin Long with the consultant firm of Coder Engineering is in charge of the survey.
