
Rock Creek Bridge on K-146 to close for repairs

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) expects to begin making repairs to the Rock Creek Bridge on K-146 next week. The bridge is 6.22 miles east of U.S. 59.

Starting Monday, June 20, the work zone will be closed to traffic. KDOT will sign the state route detour on K-3, K-47 and U.S. 59 (see map). KDOT awarded Mission Construction Company of St. Paul the \$287,182 construction contract. The work should be completed by late October, weather permitting.
