KDOT to repair concrete on U.S. 400 in Greenwood County

Monday, June 13, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to begin replacing concrete panels on U.S. 400 in Greenwood County. The road work will take place between K-99 and the Greenwood-Wilson county line.

U.S. 400 traffic will be reduced to one lane controlled by temporary signals. Expect brief delays at the work zone. Weather permitting, the road work should be finished by mid-July.
