## KDOT to repair concrete on U.S. 400

The week of May 30 the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to begin full-depth concrete patching on U.S. 400 between U.S. 75 and U.S. 169. Crews will replace concrete on the mile-long section that includes the South Kansas & Oklahoma Railroad crossing (see map).

U.S. 400 traffic will be reduced to one lane controlled by temporary signals. Expect brief delays at the work zone. Weather permitting, the road work should be finished in late June.
