Survey on K-33 begins this week

The week of May 9 the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) expects to start a field survey on K-33 in Franklin and Douglas counties. The survey begins at 6th Street in Wellsville and continues north to the K-33/U.S. 56 junction. The 3¹/₂-mile-long survey is based on the existing highway alignment.

Survey crew members will gather information for the detailed design of future K-33 improvements. KDOT expects the survey to be complete by July 15.

Activities include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. A member of the survey crew will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property. KDOT Field Survey Project Manager Joe Bowen will manage the survey.
