KDOT to replace crossroad pipes on three highways in Bourbon County

The week of June 27 the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to replace four crossroad pipes on three state highways in Bourbon County. The work zones will be closed to through traffic between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Commuters and local traffic should use alternate routes around the closures.

The dates and locations of the pipe replacements are as follows, weather permitting:

- Monday, June 27, K-39 between reference points 53 and 54, two pipes. K-39 will be closed from the north K-39/K-3 junction west to the K-39/U.S. 59 junction. Traffic will still be able to access K-3 north of K-39.
- Wednesday, June 29, K-31 at 8th St. in Fulton, reference point 133, one pipe.
- Thursday, June 30, K-3 at 1st St. in Uniontown, reference point 23.8, one pipe.
